

## **Trad Climbing Checklist**

Trad climbers or groups of trad climbers will need to bring all of their gear with them along the route and remove it once they've completed their passage. Trad climbers typically value exploration with a strict dedication to leaving nature unblemished by avoiding use of older means of protection such as pitons, which damage the rock.
